The Idea of Ithaca

Origin

Having some success with the transposition of a 'creative strategies' (first year) structure into Studio Arts 1 (second year) unit, the liberty was taken to further this structure (and ethos) into Studio Arts 2 (first semester, third year). The first half of the unit was thus structured in this way (a project of two prescribed parts), the second half then conceded to a self-directed format. Harry Barnett with whom I co-taught this unit conceived Part 1 'Extreme Indulgences and Corrupting Influences' and 'The Idea of Ithaca' which I devised followed from this. These were to be the final two projects we were to offer into the Fine Arts Program.

Premise

Knowing this to be my final offering, the Homeric myth of Ithaca, as a coming-home story seemed appropriate, following the 'great adventure' of the Fine Arts Program now coming to an end. A key notion I was to work with in this project was concerned with *authority*, what was it? And how could one gain it, in respect of one's own work, notions of *authenticity* was seen to equate with authorship/authority. The broad question of what constitutes 'home' then emerged as constitutive of one's own sense of authenticity or authority. The nexus between origins and originality was explored. I happened to have recently read V.S.Naipaul's "The Enigma of Arrival" an extraordinary novel that dealt with some of these concerns.

The project commenced with a *longing* to *belong*, a going-somewhere to recover something (as an act of rediscovery). To get to this 'place' a 'vessel' (homing device) needed to be purpose built to get to the destination. The 'vessel' was subject to critical engagement. The 'destination' however was presented in the absence of critique and explanation in a realm where no *justification* was required. Collectively titles were ascribed to each 'destination' which I collated and returned back to the group for reflection.

THE IDEA OF ITHACA

Part 2 of project 1 further explores the issue of *authority* in creating art. It is prompted by the question: how does art assume *authority*, what exactly do we mean by this? and what are some of the conditions necessary to render a work *authoritative*?

'The idea of Ithaca' refers to Homer's epic poem 'The Odyssey' (c700BC). This is a mythic homecoming story that charts Odysseus' heroic journey back to the place of his origin: Ithaca, and all the trials and tribulations he encounters along the way.

The idea of Ithaca is the idea of 'home', of 'coming-home'.

What constitutes 'home'?

There is a mundane sense of home, understood as a domestic place, a place where we grew up, a house somewhere. Interwoven into this dwelling is a place of first experiences much more expansive than a mere street address; a special place, a formative place, where much happens, a place that in a certain sense could be said to have *formed* us. A place we begin to mythologise.

How do we 'originate'?

If notions of originality defer to notions of origins we find ourselves in the space of *belonging*, what does it mean to 'belong'? Is belonging an attachment of some kind to a place, (this *belongs* to me, this is mine), what is that place of belonging?

How do we authenticate our existence? What is the impulse that drives the desire to be genuine?

Proposition

As an act of *belonging*, make a work that seeks to return you back to where you 'belong', (using your understanding of the notion of *belonging*.)

Propelled by *longing*, the excursion should be a *genuine* journey of *re*covery.

This part of the project (the final destination) will occur in the absence of commentary and as such should be seen as being both *unjustifiable* and *indefensible*, existing in a space anterior to language, *inexplicable* yet understood.

This work remains therefore both vulnerable and enigmatic.

To reach this work you will need to build a *vessel*, a device of transportation, a homing device to get you to your destination (your 'ithaca', your 'coming-back-home') The *vessel* needs to be purpose built to get you there.

The vessel will be scrutinised and discussed, providing the discursive site, suitably prepared for the excursion ahead.

You are required therefore to create two things:

A vessel (disclosed).
A destination (undisclosed).

Schedule:

March 26 General discussion of strategies of departure, and directions to

destination. The question of where-and-how-to-get-there?

You will need to have *sensed* your destination (undisclosed) and be in a position to discuss what will constitute your 'vessel' (disclosed)

April 2 Presentation of 'vessels'

April 9 Voyaging and Landfall (as work in progress)

General discussion of charting and trajectory.

April 16 Presentation of Arrivals (the enigmatic destiny of beginnings)
